The Grant County Health Department has reported 74, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 3 deaths in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 11,210 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 562 deaths and 61,142 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

Grant County is currently experiencing a COVID-19 virus outbreak. However most of these new cases are mainly confined to at least one long-term care facility and not at MGH.

Our mission remains the same and that is to support the Grant County Health Department, Marion General Hospital and Long-term Care Facilities located in Grant County.
