The Grant County Health Department has reported **11 confirmed cases of COVID-19** in Grant County

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 3,039 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 65 deaths and 16,285 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

At this time there are no reported shortages of Healthcare workers at MGH or any long-term care facility in Grant County. Below are the stats for the first responder organizations in the county;
