0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported **3 confirmed cases of COVID-19** in Grant County

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 477 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 14 deaths and 3,356 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

The biggest concerns we have right now is a Shortage of PPE for Healthcare workers. The best way that every member of the public can assist us with this issue truly is to do the following.

Practice good Social Distancing, this helps us because every person that doesn't get sick won't need to use any much needed PPE. This also has a direct effect on our Healthcare Workers by keeping the amount of patients entering the hospital manageable.

Secondly, delay minor medical procedures (teeth cleaning, Dr. Appointments ect.)

Third and maybe most importantly, Stay home and stay safe.

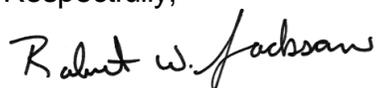
